MATERIALS NEEDED:

SWX105 – BB-8 Bank

Duncan® Concepts®:

- CN213 – Dark Taupe
- CN052 – Bright Tangerine
- CN202 – Bright Grey
- CN353 – Dark Sapphire
- CN253 – Black

Duncan® Discovery Brushes:

- BR529 – No. 4 Round
- BR530 – No. 8 Round
- BR601 – Liner

Other Supplies:

- Potter's Sponge



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PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS:

Before you begin, wipe a damp sponge over entire bisque to remove dust and contaminants.

1. Paint 1 thick coat of Dark Taupe all over the outside of the bank until no white is showing.
2. When the color has lost its shine, take a slightly damp sponge and gently wipe the color off the pottery. You want to wipe lightly, removing the color from just the raised parts of the texture. This will leave the color in just the cracks, giving it an antiqued look. For best results, continually rinse your sponge in your water bowl while you wipe, as needed, and squeeze out the water well so it doesn't drip onto your pottery.
3. Paint 2 coats of Bright Tangerine on the circles and other appropriate details.
4. Paint 2 coats of Dark Sapphire on the round detail at the top of the bank.
5. Paint 2 coats of Bright Grey on the appropriate details around the bank.
6. Paint 3 coats of Black on the large and small circle on the front of the bank.
7. Clear glaze then stilt and fire to cone 06.
